# Taking a course for...

## ...non-credit

At the end of the semester:

- get a grade or “audit”
- get a *grade-report sheet* on letterhead “stationery” in the form of a pdf file by email

## ...credit

- You get a grade or “audit”
- You get a grade report sheet **AND** an official transcript issued by St Olaf’s School of Records mailed to the address you provide to our US office
- Can be declared any time, even after you get your grade
- Costs an additional 850USD

*Note: It varies by homeschool how your grades are credited*

# What does **auditing a class** mean?

You “audit” a class if you show up for course meetings throughout the semester. Thus eg exchanging a grade you get at the end of the semester for an “audit” clearly satisfies this condition since you will be doing much more work for a grade. You can also switch to auditing earlier in the course.

But watching recordings of lectures “only” does not qualify for receiving a grade report sheet with an “audit” for a course.
