

The price/km should be displayed!






Use common sense when making friends on the street

Hungary has ZERO tolerance on drugs (and alcohol, when driving – this includes scooters!)





In Europe, always carry an ID with you – police can stop and check on you!

- → your residency permit
- → until you get it: eg your driver's licence & copy of your passport's data page

You need your passport to buy a sim card!

Your Housing

Ground rules:

- → Make yourself at home.
- → Please respect your neighbors.
- → Don't smoke in the apartment.
- → Keep the apartment in the same condition as it was received

Read Your contract!

- Clean the apartment at least every two weeks can get a cleaning person do that.
- → If cleaning is provided by the landlord, make sure the cleaning person can get into the apartment and has room to clean.
- → Take out the garbage, wash dishes regularly/daily
- → Recycle paper and plastic/metal
- → Nothing can be put on the walls unless previously discussed with the landlord.
- → Do not throw or poured solid stuff into the drains
- → If anything breaks or goes out of order let the landlord know ASAP.

Discuss with your landlord how your electricity and gas will be calculated!

Please, be understanding – there are major changes going on that we, Hungarians do not know ahead of time either

Help maintain a good relationship with the landlords!


